Dear friends,

One of my favorite things about my job with Reformed University Fellowship is being able to say that I'm serving at its original campus! RUF, as you may know, is our denomination's campus ministry, but it is also a child of the Presbyterian churches here in Hattiesburg! **And this spring we celebrate the 50th anniversary of its birth!** 

It was in the school year of 1972-1973 that the first official "RUF" gatherings occurred, with Mark Lowrey – a son of FPC – serving as its first minister, on behalf of the local Presbyterian churches. It began with Mark simply knocking on dorm room doors and inviting students to a Bible study. Since then, that ministry has not only taken root here in Hattiesburg, it has bloomed across the country and around the world.

Today, half a century after those first dorm room Bible studies, RUF is on over 140 campuses, from Manhattan to Miami and from Western

Carolina to Western Washington. Our ministry today also welcomes the nations in through **RUF-International** and even stretches around the world through **RUF-Global** in places like Mexico, Japan, West Africa, and Ukraine.
